# *Minutes of the twenty fifth General Body Meeting*

The 25<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body meeting of The Indian Society for Hydraulics (ISH) was held on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021 at 1800 hrs online, during HYDRO-2020 International conference held at NIT Rourkela, Odisha. About 54 members attended the meeting. The meeting started with a welcome address by Prof.M.C.Deo, President ISH.

## **1.0 Confirmation of the Minutes of Twenty fourth General Body Meeting**

The minutes of the 24<sup>th</sup> General Body meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2019 at Hotel Marriot, Hyderabad hosted by Osmania University were circulated to the members through ISH News published in Jan 2020 for kind perusal, comments and suggestions. The minutes were also read out at the meeting and as there were no oral or written comments, the minutes were confirmed.

## **2.0 Secretary's Report:**

ISH Executive Committee met thrice (online) during the year 2020-21 to discuss various issues.

- ISH secretariat has sent updated list of life members during first week of March 2021 to Taylor & Francis (T&F).
- During last one year the ISH membership has increased by 41 which is quite significant progress
- **IAHR Membership 2021**

This year annual IAHR membership was processed through ISH secretariat and as decided by EC each and every member who had opted for availing ISH-IAHR membership received invoice individually from IAHR and hopefully most of the members have availed this facility. Further, we are yet to receive communication from IAHR regarding the details of ISH members opted for IAHR membership this year. But we are getting reminders for few members who have not made payment towards membership. Some members expressed their inability to process it individually online

and requested us to process. But we have declined this as it is very cumbersome process for making payment as we need to get details from our Chartered Accountant before processing payment with additional banking charges as well. This action was further approved during the EC meeting.

- **ISH News Letter Publication**

During the EC meeting it was decided that the ISH Newsletter publication would be online only to save environment and to avoid posting, pasting charges, etc.

- Newsletter will be available on website in the publication TAB
- Suggestion received to send via link not as attachment on email is under consideration.

- **Payment of publishing charges towards ISH journal to Taylor & Francis**

As per the agreement with T&F (UK), ISH has paid \$ 5900.00 including 18% GST towards ISH members online access to 'Journal of Hydraulic Engineering' volume 26 issue 1 - 3, for the year 2020 for 1000 members which is minimum as per contract and the amount is about Rs. 4.5 Lakh.

- **Report on HYDRO 2019 International**

"HYDRO-2019 International: Conference on Hydraulics, Water Resources, Coastal and Environmental Engineering" was held during 18th to 20th December, 2019 at Marriott Hotel & Convention Centre organised by Department of Civil Engineering, Osmania University (OU), Hyderabad. It represented a link in the chain of such "HYDRO" conferences held annually at different places in India since 1995 under the auspices of Indian Society for Hydraulics. This was the 24th HYDRO conference and the major theme was "Hydraulics, Water Resources, Coastal and River Engineering". Prof. Gopal Naik and Prof. Shashikanth took the responsibility of organizing and managing the conference which was very successfully conducted.

The HYDRO 2019 Conference was inaugurated by Dr. R.K. Gupta, Chairman, Krishna River Management Board (KRMB), C. Nagendra Rao, E&C Administration, Irrigation Department (Telangana State), Dr. (Mrs.) V.V. Bhosekar, President, The Indian Society for Hydraulics (ISH). Prof. M. Kumar, Principal, Osmania University welcomed all dignitaries and research fellows from different parts of the country and abroad as well. The dignitaries and the keynote speakers enlightened all present about the importance of research and innovation and its application in these fields.

The various themes of the conference were Hydro Environment, Modelling Techniques, Soft Computing Techniques, Geospatial Techniques, River Hydraulics, Groundwater Hydrology, Water Management and Hydro informatics, Water and Wastewater

Modelling, Ports and Coastal Engineering. Around 400 delegates representing academic institutions, research labs, consulting engineers and administrative bodies attended the conference. Total 520 research papers were received out of which 370 were finally accepted and presented in six parallel sessions. Additionally, ten experienced researchers from academic institutions and research labs around the world gave invited talks on state-of-the-art works carried out by them in the water sector. A special session on “Impact of climate change on Indian Coast” was conducted by Ocean Engineering Department of IIT, Madras. Prof.Sannasiraj and Prof.V.Sundar took the lead in arranging this session. A special session on the scheme of “Mission Kakathiya” and “Kaleshwaram Project” was held which was appreciated by the audience. On the last day before valedictory session a panel discussion was held by eminent personalities about the present scenario of water management across the country and possible solutions to tackle the rising demand for water with sustainable approach.

The valedictory session was held on 20th evening at 5 PM. The chief Guest was Prof. Atal Choudhary, Vice Chancellor, VSSUT, Burla, Odisha along with the following dignitaries Prof. Gopal Reddy, Registrar, OU, Prof. P V N Prasad, Dean Faculty of Engineering, OU, Prof. Gopal Naik, Head CED, OU and Dr.L.R.Ranganath, Secretary, ISH. Once again, the dignitaries reiterated the importance of water conservation and effective utilization. Few participants expressed their views about the conference and appreciated the efforts by the organizers. Prof. G.S.Dwarakish from NITK, Suratkal, suggested to allocated more time for the presenting the papers and advised to replace mementoes with books in future. The valedictory session was concluded with vote of thanks.

Further during the discussions one of the member sought for the guidelines for ISH Fellow Membership and it was told that there is no specific guidelines but the member should have sufficient experience in the field of Hydraulics and Water Resources or Coastal Engineering Field with at least twenty years of experience. Hence, members suggested preparing a guideline by compiling the suggestions from the present EC Members which was approved during the last EC Meeting.



## **ISH Fellow Membership Criteria (Approved by EC)**

During the meeting the following eligibility criteria for ISH Fellow Membership was finalized:

- *Minimum age - 40 years.*
- *Minimum Bachelor degree in relevant areas with 15 years of total professional experience.*
- *Preferable qualification: Post graduation or Ph.D. in the relevant area – with relevant professional works/publications.*
- *Minimum of 10 years of experience in the area of hydraulics, ocean engineering, water resources, hydro-environment - as Academic, consultant, scientist or engineer.*
- *Minimum 3 years as member of ISH and involvement in ISH activities.*
- *Publications in ISH Journal of Hydraulic Engineering, organization of workshop/conferences/symposium in collaboration with ISH. Also, if they possess any award from ISH (best paper, or any annual awards) will be an added advantage.*
- *Suggested fees: Rs. 5000/-.*
- *In case of exceptional candidates, EC may give due considerations. In addition to guidelines, ISH is also authorized to nominate persons of eminence / academicians / field engineers working in area of hydraulics and water resources for the fellowship.*

Shri.R.M.Khatsuria, suggested sharing the profiles of fellow member on website and it was agreed to implement it in phased manner.

### **1. ISH Life and Fellow Membership Fees**

Secretary informed that the ISH life membership fees which was to be enhanced according to the approval accorded during the 24<sup>th</sup> GB meeting in December 2019 at HYDRO 2019 at OU, Hyderabad could not be implemented due to Covid19. Hence, it was decided to increase the ISH Life membership fee to 3000/- and Fellow membership increased to 5000 from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.

### **2. Proposal for establishment of Student Chapter at NIT, Silchar, Assam.**

Prof. D.G. Regulwar suggested asking proposal for Local centre like Aurangabad as student cannot work for long due to their temporary affiliation to the institute. Further it was suggested that the members of the proposed local chapter/centre should be ISH life members.

Prof. P. L. Patel, suggested that at least 50 ISH members should be there for awarding local chapter. Hence, it was decided to communicate/respond accordingly.

#### v. **HYDRO 2021**

Prof. P.L.Patel from SVNIT has submitted a proposal for hosting HYDRO 2021, the proposal was discussed during the EC meeting and was approved and it was suggested to ISH secretary to convey the decision as it is already late and the formal approval can be taken during the forthcoming GB meeting during HYDRO 2020 online.

#### vi. **HYDRO 2022 Proposal**

ISH secretariat has received brief proposal for hosting the HYDRO 2022 conference from Prof. Vikas Garg, Central University, Haryana.

Further, Prof.K.Khatua from NIT Rourkela has requested orally during the EC meeting for hosting the event as they could not host the event physically during HYDRO 2020.

Prof. Javed Alam from Aligarh Muslim University has shown interest in hosting the conference by oral communication.

### **3.0 Treasurer's Report**

#### **3.1 Auditor's Report**

During 2019 ISH has associated with International conference **HYDRO 2019** at Hotel Marriot, Hyderabad, organised by Osmanina University. ISH has Rs. Received contribution of Rs 1.28 L towards the welfare of the society from HYDRO 2019 organised by Osmanina University, Hyderabad,.

As we know INCHOE conference was organised at CWPRS during 2018, some part of the sponsorship including Ministerial financial assistance (From Ministry of Jal Shakti) was received in 2019. So, ISH has received about 3.62 Lakhs in terms of sponsorship and ISH membership fees. Also, ISH has received about Rs. 3.85 lakhs from bank interests. So, at the end of financial year 2019-20 i.e. as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020, the total income over expenditure was about Rs. 5.65 Lakhs.

#### **During current year following are the major expenses were incurred.**

Since last GB apart from the routine expenditures, major expences were incurred towards HYDRO 2019 conference for awards and Trophy about Rs. 71,000/- . Remittance of \$ 5900/- including GST has been made towards the online access of ISH members to T&F and a Personal Computer amounting to Rs. 73,500/- has been purchased for ISH office at CWPRS, Pune

As of 22 March 2021, ISH is having a balance of Rs. 5,15,896/- in the saving account and Rs. 56,98,912/- in the form of FD accounts in the Canara Bank.

So, the total corpus of ISH is Rs. 62,14,808/- (Rupees Sixty-two lakh Forteen thousand Eight hundred & eight only)

### **3.2 Position of ISH Deposit**

Fixed deposits which attained the maturity period have been renewed and re-deposited in the same bank or the other and details are in Annexure-II.

### **3.3 Budget for the year 2020-21**

The budget for 2020-21 was submitted and details are enclosed in Annexure-III for the approval of the GB.

The Audited accounts for the year 2019-20 and the Budget for the year 2020-21 were approved by the General body.

## **4.0 Editor's Report**

Prof M. C. Deo, Chairman, ISH-JHE Editorial Board, briefed the status of ISH Journal publication. It was informed that February 2021 Issue is ready for publication. It is planned to publish 4 issues in the year 2021 containing total of 50 papers. Waiting period for publication has been raised from 1 year to 1.5 years due to submission of increased manuscripts. It was also informed that 3 issues/volumes has been already published which has 41 articles with the present approved 360 pg/yr. Further, T&F has agreed to increase pages up to 480 per year at additional cost for publication. It may take 3 yrs by 2021 to make 5-6 issues and more pages. Prof. T.I.Eldho suggested going step by step to increase the volume depending on the inflow of manuscripts which was agreed upon. It was informed that by June 2021, 600 pages are required to be published to clear backlog which would be costing around Rs. 7 Lakhs. It was agreed upon to get the invoice accordingly from T&F. Secretary opined that this can be taken up to enable clearance of backlog as we have funds for the same. It may be noted that 40-45% manuscripts are rejected at initial stages. It was informed that the authors would be suggested to submit papers with their own referee list to save the processing time. Presently the Cite Score of the Journal is 2.0 while the SCIMago Journal Rank (SJR) is 0.37 and the Source Normalized Impact per paper (SNIP) is 1.03.

Further, during the discussions Shri.R.M.Khatsuria suggested to consider papers related to core hydraulics only as the journal was initiated with this view. Several members debated on this issue and Prof. V. Jothiprakash, suggested considering diversified manuscripts and Reviewers and editors know about the subject whether it is hydraulics or published anywhere else. Finally it was agreed upon to continue with the present system.

## 5.0 Other Points:

- Revision of ISH life membership fee to Rs. 3000/- for professionals Rs. 2000/- for students has been approved by General Body and will come into effect from April 2021 onwards.
- Proposal for student/Local chapter of Osmania University is approved by General Body.
- List of HYDRO conferences, Minutes of meeting, Photos, etc. would be updated & published on Website as per suggestions received from General Body.
- Approval for engaging Chartered Accountants for the year 2021-2022 was granted to continue with the present Ms. MRO & Associates, Pune


